**THE POPE'S INTENTIONS FOR JANUARY: Pray with the Word of God.**

Let us pray that praying with the Word of God be nourishment for our lives and a source of hope in our communities, helping us to build a more fraternal and missionary Church.

**SOCIETY FOR THE PROTECTION OF UNBORN CHILDREN – WHITE FLOWER APPEAL:** There will be a Second Collection in aid of SPUC at all Masses on **Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> January**. SPUC exists to transform culture so that abortion is not only abolished but becomes unthinkable, and seeks to restore respect for the sanctity of human life from conception to natural death. This year's appeal postcards allow supporters to join the fightback campaign against the current attempts in Parliament to expand abortion and allow assisted suicide.
